Critical Thinking: Strengthening decision-making through structured reasoning and reflective analysis. Strategic Planning: Learning how to set goals, plan actions, and assess outcomes effectively. Public Speaking: Developing impactful delivery, structuring content, and engaging with an audience meaningfully. Negotiation: Understanding negotiation frameworks, practicing scenario-based techniques, and exploring conflict resolution. Following the sessions, a structured feedback and assessment form was administered to capture insights and areas for improvement. Participants were also provided with post-workshop reading materials to continue their learning journey. In addition to the high-quality academic experience, participants appreciated the excellent food arrangements provided throughout the day, which contributed to the overall comfort and positive atmosphere of the workshop. CBee LIVE successfully met its objective of empowering future healthcare professionals with foundational skills that support holistic development. It served	

as a platform to inspire leadership, empathy, and innovation within medical communities.
